Best practices and procedures to prevent the spread of COVID-19:

Over the next few months, when our guests are here at the Inn at Tusculum Farm, they will notice numerous additional procedures and changes in all areas of the Inn and in our customer service. Specific areas of focus will include:

Monitoring the Health of our Staff:

Our employees will have their temperature checked at the beginning of each shift and will be sent home if they have an above-normal temperature. We will be recording this information and keeping it on file. If any of our employees are feeling ill or showing any symptoms such as shortness of breath or dry cough, they will be required to stay home until they do not have any symptoms for 3 days. All of our employees will be required to wear masks while at work. We have added signage throughout the properties to remind everyone about social distancing protocols and the need to frequently wash their hands and use sanitizer.

Sanitizing and Cleaning of General Areas:

In public spaces, we will be requiring our staff to thoroughly treat high-touch surface areas with hospital-grade disinfectants. This cleaning will be done on an increased regularly scheduled basis. Our staff will be monitoring the use of the public restrooms so we can ensure that they are checked and disinfected after each use.

We are keeping books and decorations on our shelves. If you remove anything off of a shelf in a shared space, please *do not put the item back*. Please leave the object out so we can identify it and disinfect it before replacing the item back on the shelves.

Check-in procedure:

We have moved to a contactless check in. We will greet you in our parking lot upon arrival and answer any questions, comments or concerns. We will also provide a outdoor tour of the property. Our Select Registry kiosk will be sanitized before and after each use. We have removed all magazines and our guest directory from the rooms. This digital guest book will be available during your stay, so please save the link and send it to other guests in your group.

Guest Room/Amenities Sanitizing Procedures:

In guest rooms, we are cleaning all surfaces thoroughly with hospital-grade disinfectants. We will also be placing disinfecting sprays in each house for guests' personal use. We have also removed the in-room pens and note pads. If a guest would like a pen or notepad during their stay, please ask your innkeeper for one. Our guest bicycles will be sanitized before and after each use. For fishing at Tusculum Farm, we ask that you bring your own gear, but we are happy to provide bait.

Our Pool & Screened Porch Area

The pool is heated and treated with chlorine. We have worked with our pool partner to make sure that all of our chemicals are set to the best of knowledge to kill the COVID-19 virus. In most cases, there is at least 24hours between guest uses of these areas. We have included hand sanitizer on the pool counter for guests to use. The bathrooms are cleaned daily, but because you are the only group on site, we are only monitoring these bathrooms daily vs hourly. However, we ask that you please continue to wash your hands at all times after using our public areas.

The Screened Porch is open for guests. There are supplies in the cabinets that you are welcome to use. They are cleaned between each guest stay. If you use or touch any of these supplies, please leave them on the counter so that we know to clean for the next guests. You are also welcome to use the refrigerator in this area for snacks/drinks/meals you might want to enjoy from this space.
